Theology is called as well to take the initiative and to set out on the road to go out and heal the wounds of suffering humanity that often lives without a goal and lacking the meaning of the sense of life. In particular, this vocation belongs to fundamental Theology which by nature is placed along the boundaries of society, anxious to listen like Paul in Athens to the questions of people of our time to make our hope credible, and to promote reason endowed with the meaning that makes faith the center and the form of life.

In this perspective, the offer of a specialization arises from the center of a “*kerygmatic-kaiological*” Fundamental Theology model that, on one hand, reflects speculatively on the foundation of faith, or the revelation of God in his eschatological fulfillment in Jesus Christ, crucified and risen, which pours out the fullness of the Holy Spirit, considered in all its breadth in the history of salvation; and on the other, concerned with credibly translating and effectively making this revelation the “guiding star of man” for people culturally placed in contexts, with a particular attention to the reflection on religious experience in post-modernity, considered theologically and philosophically also in its artistic expressions.
